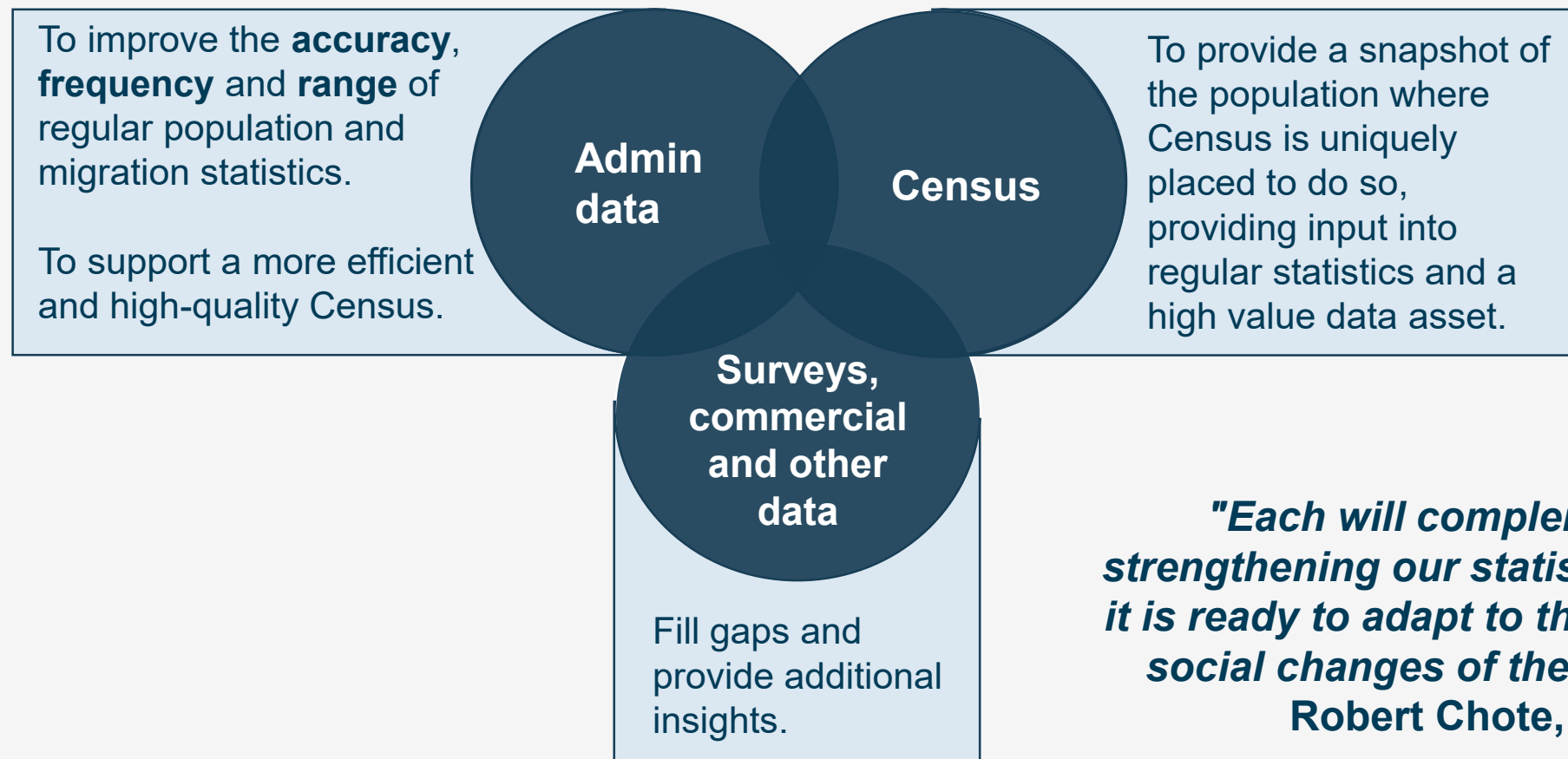

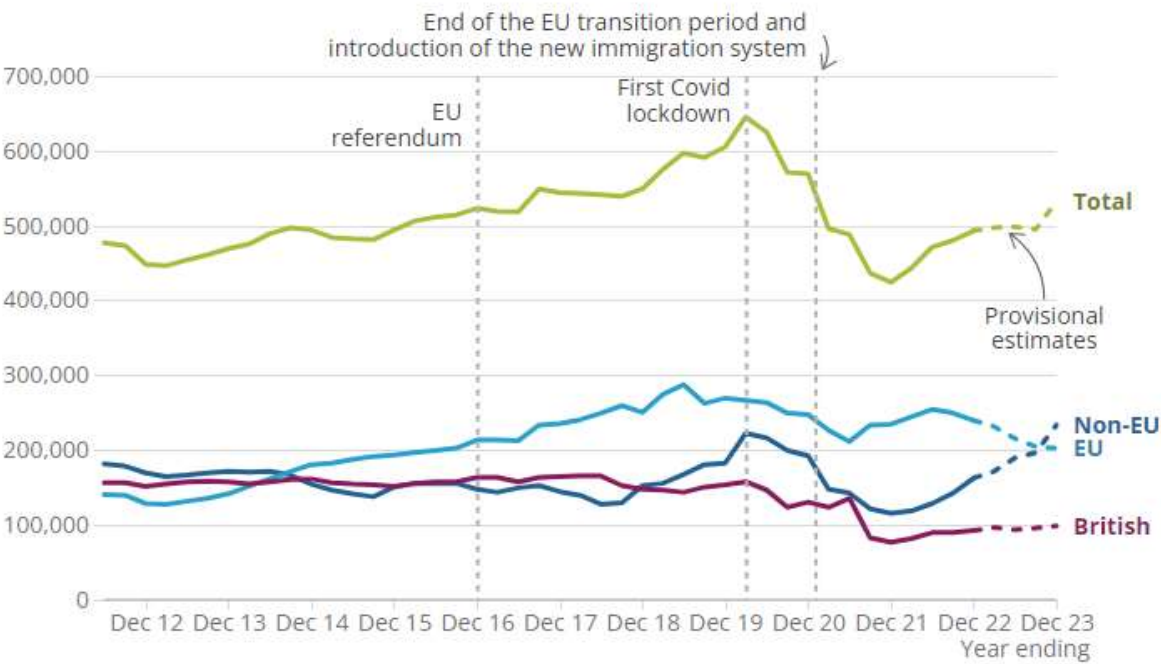
What?

- Forecasts and planning (eg government fiscal events, benefits forecasts, planning of services including education and health).
- Funding allocation eg funding of devolved governments through the **Block Grant Adjustment** and **Barnett Formula**
- Charities use our statistics to help **target their support** and help build a case for the funding they need

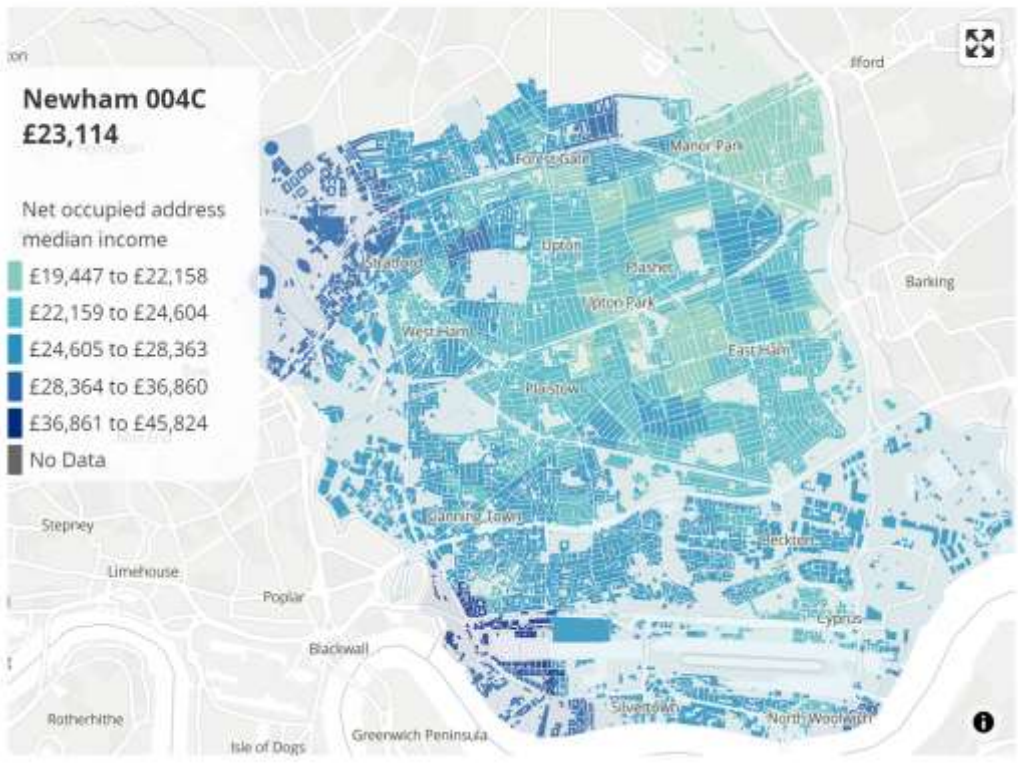


Examples

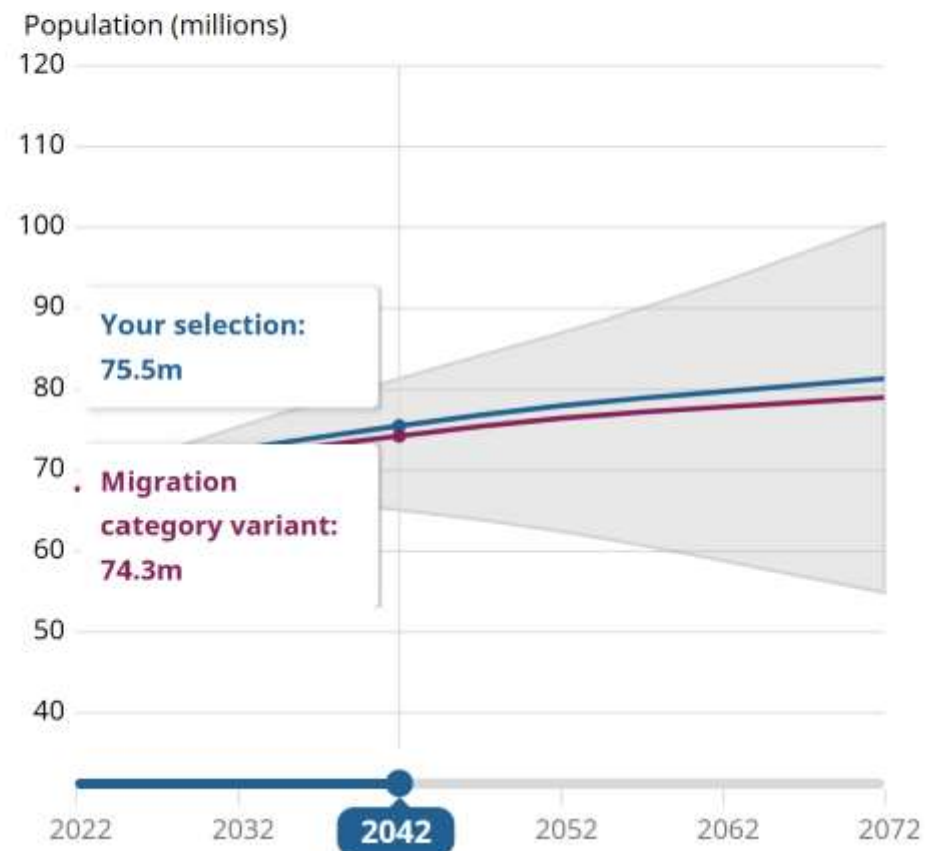

Planned Developments



- **Veterans:** Estimates by Local Authority 28 August (in development)
- **Longitudinal:** We are planning a launch event 15 October to promote the availability of new data
- **International Migration:** Method updates will be published 14 November (in advance of November estimates).
- **Income:** Developing plans Household Finance and income, aim to publish Small Area Income Estimates by end of the year
- **Households:** Number and size of households by LA in December, date tbc. In development output, including quality and methods information.
- **Provisional population estimates:** Developing a method with the aim of publishing provisional estimates in Winter 25/26, providing an early indication which will be updated in Summer 2026.

Topic Consultation Vision and Objectives

- If the recommendation is accepted by government, ONS will conduct a Topic Consultation in Autumn 2025.

The topic consultation will build on our understanding of user needs to support the development of the population and migration statistical system including the 2031 Census and beyond
