## Obesity: cross-sectional micro data

Key data (objective measurements; annual data):

- Health Survey for England
- Scottish Health Survey
- Welsh Health Survey
- National Child Measurement Programme

Other data:

- National Survey for Wales
- NI Health Survey
- British Social Attitudes: certain years e.g. 2015
- Opinions and Lifestyle survey

(was Omnibus Survey): certain years e.g. Omnibus 2003; April 2004





## **Health Survey for England**

- Monitors the health of the English population:
  - Commissioned by NHS Digital and Carried out by NatCen and UCL
- Annual survey, 1991 onwards:
  - Annual snapshot of nation's health
  - Track trends over time
- Sample from Postcode Address File
  - 8,000 adults and 2,000 children (boosts from time to time)
- Face-to-face data collection
  - Interviewer and nurse visits

## National Child Measurement Programme

- Funded by NHS Digital
- Annual data from 2006/7
- All children in state maintained primary schools
  - Reception Year (aged 4-5)
  - Year 6 (aged 10-11) s in England
- Anthropometric measurements
  - trained healthcare professionals in schools
- Dataset is a 'reduced' version of the full dataset
  - 2012-13: 1,078,555 pupils from 17,105 schools
